UNITED MISSIONARY  
SOCIETIES IN SESSION

Meeting Held in St. Andrew's Church Yesterday Afternoon — Reports Received and Officers Elected.

The attendance at the United Missionary Societies meeting held at St. Andrew's church yesterday afternoon was so large that it necessitated adjourning from the school room into the church. Mrs. J. MacPherson presided and led the devotional service with which the session opened.

The chief speaker of the afternoon was Mrs. Baughman, of the College of Missionaries, Indianapolis, who delivered a practical and spirited address upon Mission Work in Africa and the help that could be given at home.

Mrs. Baughman referred to the fact that Africa was at first Christianized but that later the people grew wealthy and materialistic, and that the Christian religion was wiped out. Then came Mohammedanism, which is essentially a missionary religion. To the believer in this, the more infidel slain the greater his hope of a high place in the Mohammedan heaven. The speaker described the race with which Christian missionaries had to deal, a people child-like and affectionate. One church in Africa which has only been established fifteen years yet supports 60 native helpers—truly an example to churches in this western land. There are forty million pagans in Africa and yet in that place the travelling missionary was met at the wharf by 2,000 black men who sang a Christian hymn.

The Mohammedans have a way of describing three kinds of prayers—from the lips, from the head and from the heart—and Mrs. Baughman urged her hearers very eloquently to make this year a year of prayer, that kind

of prayer which comes from the heart. She also pointed out the need to make money equal zeal and show by support the realization of the great work for the Master. She recommended very highly two books for study, "The Lure of Africa," and "The African Trail," by Jean MacPherson.

At the close of this inspiring talk the president thanked the speaker and asked that the Chataqua salute be given her as a greeting from the Canadian women present. Mrs. Baughman replied feelingly.

The next address was given by Mrs. J. A. McAvity, who took the place of Mrs. Burlington Ham, who was unable through illness to be present.

Mrs. McAvity spoke on the work of the Young Women's Christian Association and its connection with the church, the wideness of its activities. Travellers' Aid work and the great need of a building in St. John where all the different branches could be gathered together under one roof. She told of how much had been done in England by the Y. W. C. A. where it has been to the girls in the munition factories what the Y. M. C. A. has been to the men. Mrs. McAvity also told most interestingly of a Japanese student who had returned to her native country and was there laboring along the lines of this splendid institution.
