

PRACTICAL CHEMISTRY.

The laboratory of Practical Chemistry is probably second to none in the Dominion in the matter of fittings, no expense having been spared to make the room convenient and useful to the students, each of whom performs for himself every operation of the course, which embraces Inorganic and Organic Chemistry, Toxicology and Urinary Analysis, and is kept within the limits of that which will be of ultimate practical value, rather than that which would be merely crammed and then forgotten.

MATERIA MEDICA AND PHARMACY.

In this course special attention will be given to the most important drugs and their preparations.

A complete collection of the different medicinal agents in their various forms is at the disposal of this department, and will be utilized to make the student familiar with the drugs.

THERAPEUTICS.

LECTURER—DR. FERGUSON.

Instruction in this department will embrace a practical study of the Physiological and Therapeutical action of the more important officinal drugs, together with instruction in the properties and uses of newer remedies of reputed therapeutic value. Incompatibility of drugs, and the theory and art of prescribing will receive due attention.
