manufacturer thereof; but all other lumber shipped for exportation by sea, shall be either measured, culled or counted (at the option of the parties) by a licensed culler. under the control and superintendence of the Supervisor. 5 under a penalty equal to the market value of any article of lumber so illegally shipped; and such penalty shall be recoverable before any Court of competent jurisdiction, from the owner or shipper, or from the proprietor or proprietors, lessee or lessees of the premises from 10 which such lumber shall have been so illegally shipped; and it shall be sufficient in order to establish that such lumber has been illegally shipped for exportation by sea. to prove that it is or has been placed along-side any seagoing vessel; and proof of the measuring, culling or 15 counting of any such lumber under the provisions of this Act shall fall upon the party charged with such illegal shipping, and the market value of any article of lumber so illegally shipped, shall be ascertained by the certificate of the Council of the Quebec Board of Trade, or by 20 certificate under the hand of the Supervisor, or by any other legal proof of such value; Provided always that Proviso: This the provisions of this Act shall not extend or be construed Act not to affect places beto extend to any place below the eastern end of the low eastern end of island
