

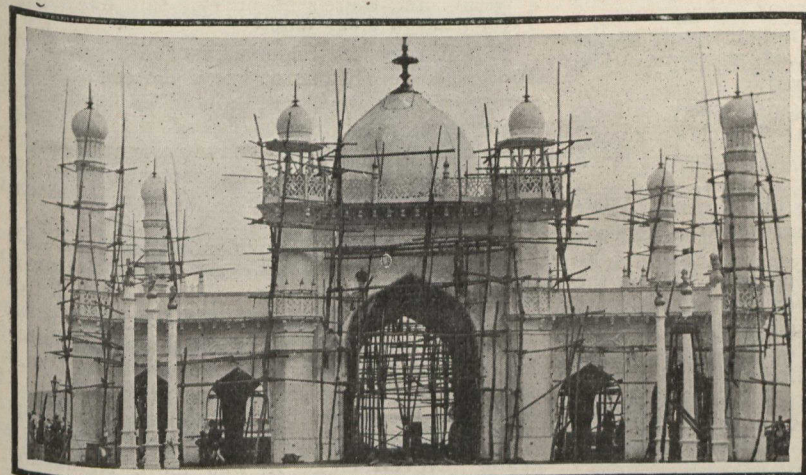
THE BURNING OF HANKOW CITY
