## September

- 2 Labour Day — University closed
- 3 Classes Begin, Outpost Nursing
- 5 Classes Begin unless otherwise specified, Regular session
- Last day for refund on first instalment of fees — limited enrolment programs
- 19 Last day to cancel registration in or to add "A" and "R" classes, Regular Session
- Last day to register with late fee
- Last day to apply for Honours Programs
- Last day to change from Dalhousie University to King's College and vice versa

## October

- 14 Thanksgiving Day — University closed
- 18 Last day to withdraw from "A" classes with a "W"
- Last day to change "A" classes from credit to audit and vice versa
- Last day for partial refund of first — fees
- 19 Fall Convocation

## November

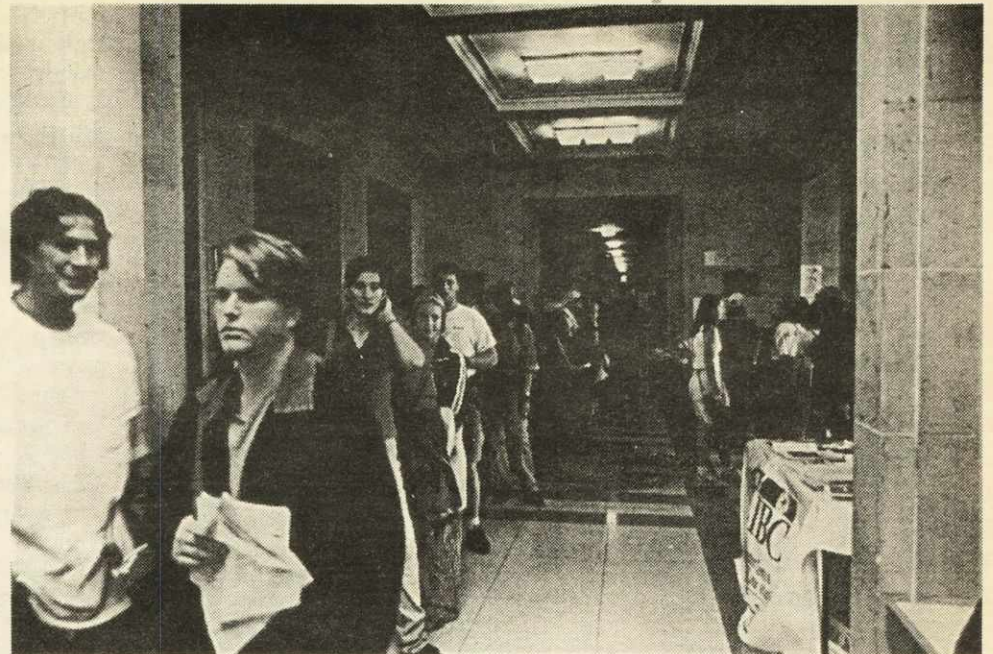
- 8 Last day to withdraw from "A" classes
- 11 Remembrance Day — University closed
- 15 Last day to apply for admission to Winter term

- 6 Classes resume, unless otherwise specified, second term begins
