I am directed by the commanding Officer to desire that you will make out a Requisition for Mideverroit the Indian that acted as guide to the Party in search of Deserter, for Ten Pounds of Pork and Ten Pounds of Bread as also a Requisition for Mrs. Menard an Indian Woman as a Reward for her husband's services who volunteered as Assistant to the Party, for sixteen Pounds of bread and twenty five Pounds of Pork Mrs. Menard did not receive any Provision from the Store this Year - I am the Honor to be Sir
