


Ottawa, 1st December, 1902-

Sir,

In reply to your letter (not dated) asking for another year in which to pay the arrears against your property on the Papaschase Indian Reserve, viz:- the S.W. 1/4 Sec. 2- 52 - 24 W. 4 N. I have to inform you that in view of the large accumulation of purchase money and interest now due, and that several extensions of time have been already given you, as well as six regular Notices, unless a substantial payment is made on this property through the local Agent, Mr. A. G. Harrison, of Edmonton, within one month, the question of cancelling the Sale and resuming the land, will have to be considered by the Department.
