I beg to inform you that Mr. Inspector Ramsden in connection with his investigation of the Garden River Reserve, reports that Batchewana Indians building there are not wanted, and in connection therewith I beg to refer you to communication addressed you on the 15th of September, 1905, and to ask you to favour the Department with a full report in regard to all members of Batchewana Band residing on Garden River, giving quantity of land occupied by each, nature and extent of improvements and stating what action you would recommend should be taken in each case.
