Sir,-

I beg to draw attention to letter to you of the 31st October, and previous correspondence, regarding refunds to be made by Indians of White Bear's Band for seed and twine supplied. You were told in that letter that you should consult with Commissioner Graham in the matter. If you have not already acted upon those instructions, you should do so without delay. I may say that the Department considers that the Indians assisted are well able to refund the cost of the seed, and therefore it is expected that you will make collection of the money due. Your report in this matter will be expected after you have consulted with Commissioner Graham.
