providing further machinery for the prevention and settlement of labour disputes; particularly those in mines and public utilities.

The Alien Labour Act

to protect Canadian workmen from the competition of alien workmen brought to Canada under contract

The Lord's Day Act

Ensuring rest on Sunday to the great majority of workers

The Fair Wages resolution

of the House of Commons in 1900 is the basis of the Government's policy by which contractors for Dominion Government works and supplies are required to pay the rate of wages prevailing in the district where the work is done.

The Government Annuities Act

passed in 1908, was designed primarily for the advantage of persons of small and moderate incomes who wished to secure for their old age an assured income.
