Sir:-

I have the honor to inform you that the following is the quantity of clothing which is being sent in for the destitute Indians in your District, viz:-

230 Blankets. 400 yards Serge.

90 pairs Trousers 50 yards Stoffe

The blankets should be all wool, grey, to weigh not less than 10 lbs per pair to have a blue stripe $\frac{1}{4}$ inch wide running lengthwise and crosswise and to measure 72 x 90 inches wide. Cost 41 $\frac{1}{8}$ per lb.

The Serge - patterns of each color enclosed herewith - should be all wool grey 28 inches wide to weigh not less than 12 oz per yard. Cost 34 $\frac{7}{8}$ per yard.

The Stoffe to be of all wool, with dark blue stripe $\frac{1}{4}$ inch wide at one edge, to weigh 16 oz to the yard of 28 inches wide. Cost 41 $\frac{7}{8}$ per yard.
