

*Masters and Past Masters of Lodges to wear in lieu
and in the places of the three rosettes on
the Master Mason's apron, perpendicular
lines upon horizontal lines, thereby
forming three several sets of two right
angles; the length of the horizontal
lines to be two inches and half each, and
of the perpendicular lines one inch:
these Emblems to be of ribbon half an
inch broad, and of the same color as the
lining and edging of the Apron.*

The Master is responsible for the due observance of
the Laws relating to private Lodges, and
must produce all books, minutes, and
accounts, when required by any lawful
authority.

The Wardens or officers of a Lodge cannot be removed
by the Master, except by consent of the
Lodge after investigation of the cause
of complaint against them.
