THE CANADIAN NORTH-WEST
HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.


#### Abstract

Any even numbered section of Dominion Territories, excepting 8 and or the North-west been homesteaded, or reserved to provide wood  sole head of a fay any person who is the years of age, to the extent of onequate over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter sec- tion of 160 acres, nore or less.

ENTRY. Entrymay be made personally at the local land oftice for the District in which the land cand be taken in situate or if the homerteader to ilesires he may of the Interioy, Othawa, the Commisaioner of ot Immisration, Winnipeg, or the Local A A ent for the district in which the land is sit uate, receivo authority for some one to nake entry for him. A fee of 810 is charged for a homestead entry.


## homestead duties

a settler who has been granted an entry for a homesteal is required by the provisions of the Dherto to pertorn the conditions connected
herewith, under one of the following plans :(1) At least six months' residence upon and
cuitivation of the land in each year during the term of three years.
(2) If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) or any person who is elizible to make
a homestead entry upon the provisions of Aet, resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the Act resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the
land entered for by such person as a homestead, the requirements of this Act as to re-
sidence prior to obtaining patent may be sidence prior to obtaining patent may be
satistied by such persion residing with the father satistied by
or mother.
(3) If a settler has obtained a patent for hia
homestcail, or a certificate for the issue of such patent or a countertifignedt in the in issue or
sumer preseribed sey this Act, and has obtained entry this Act as to residence may be satistied by residence upon the tirst homestead, if the
second homestead is in the vicinity of the first secmestead,
home
(4) If the settler has his permanent residence upo If the setular hand owned bermanent residence
of his household, the requirements of thisinity Act uphr household, the roquirements of this Act
of his to residence may be satistied by residenee as to residence may
upon the said land.

The term "vicinity" used above is meant to imacate the name cownhip or an aljoining or cornering cownship.

A settler who avails himself of the provisions
of Clauses (2) (3) or (4) must cultivate 30 . of Chauses (2)(3) or (4) must cultivate 30 acroa with buildings for their accommodation, and have besides 80 acres substantially fenced.
Every homesteader who fails to comply with
the requirements of the homestemder law is liable to have his entry cancelled. and the land may be again thrown open for entry.

## application for patent

Should be made at the end of the three years Wofore the Local Agent, Sub-Agent or the
Homeatead Inspector. Before making application for patent the settler must give siir months
notice in writing to the Commiasioner notice in wruing to the Commissioner of
Dominion Lands at Ottawa of his intention wo
do os. do so.
