CAP. I.

An ACT to prevent the further Issuing and
Circulation of Treasury Notes.
Passed the 24th of March, 1819.

WHEREAS it has been found expedient
to prevent the further issuing and circu-
lation of Notes, under and by virtue of the pro-
visions of an Act made and passed in the fifty-
eighth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled
"An Act to provide for punctuality of payment
"at the Treasury:"

Preamble . . .

58, 5, 3, 1819

*Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor,
Council, and Assembly, That from and after the pass-
ing of this Act, no further payments be made at
the Treasury of this Province in Notes, or any
Notes be issued on any account whatever, under
and by virtue of the provisions of the herein before
recited Act; but that as often hereafter as money
shall become due or payable, and Warrants be
produced for payment of the same at the Treas-
ury, the Treasurer shall pay the amount of such
Warrants*

No further pay-
ments to be made
at the Treasury in
Notes, nor any
Notes to be issued.

The Treasurer to
