The Order of the Day, for the House in Committee, on the Report of the Special Committee on the Impeachments against Louis Charles Foucher, Esquire, one of the Puisné Judges of the Court of King's Bench of the District of Montreal, being read;

Mr. Cuvillier moved, seconded by Mr. Panet, that Mr. Cuvillier may be permitted to retire previous to the House going into a Committee of the whole House, on the Report of the Special Committee to whom were referred the Impeachments against Louis Charles Foucher, Esquire.
