The House in Committee (Mr. Fraser in the Chair) went into the consideration of "A Bill in addition to and in amendment of an Act, entitled " an Act to repeal all the Acts now in force relating to trespasses, and for " making new Regulations to prevent the same"—The Speaker having resumed the Chair—The Chairman Reported, that the Committee had agreed to the same—Ordered, that the said Report be accepted, and that the Bill be engrossed.

Report was received from the Justices of the General Sessions of the Peace in the County of King's, of the sums of Money applied by them under the Act of the last Session of the General Assembly for the encourage-

ment of Parish Schools.

The House in Committee (Mr. Robinson in the Chair) went into the consideration of Ways and Means-The Speaker having resumed the Chair-The Chairman Reported, that on the business to them referred the Committee had come to the following Resolutions, to wit: That a Duty of sixpence, be laid on every gallon of Rum; nine-pence, on every gallon of Wine; eight-pence, on every gallon of Brandy and of Gin, and of other distilled Spirituous Liquors; two shillings and six-pence on every cwt. of brown Sugar; and one-penny on every gaflon of Molasses; to be imported into this Province, and that the Committee request leave to sit again—Ordered, that the said Report be accepted.

Ordered, That Mr. M'Lean, Mr. Robinson, and Mr. Leonard, be a Com-

mittee to prepare a Bill for raising a Revenue in this Province.

On the second reading of "A Bill to alter and amend an Act entitled an " Act for securing the Navigation of the River Magagawdavic."—Ordered, that the further consideration thereof be postponed until the next Session of the General Assembly; and that in the mean time a Copy thereof be read at the next General Sessions of the Peace for the County of Charlotte.
