Arab Tribes Menace Palestine.

LONDON-Very serious trouble is brewing in Palestine, according to the "News of the World," which states that General Tudor and other officials on the spot regard the future with "grave apprehension." The Arabs on the border and in Palestine itself, the paper says, may at any time attack the Jewish immigrants whom they regard with "deep rooted" hostility." The government's authority is being openly flouted by what is known at the "Moslem" Christian Association." A manifesto has been issued calling upon the population to disobey the instructions issued for the taking of the census, and the Association has decided to invoke the aid of Kemal Pasha, the Turkish Nationalist leader. 
