NANAIMO'S MINERS.

Their Compromise Rejected-Manager Robins Says the Reduction Will Last Three Months.

Another Proposition Made to the Company; But the Answer is Not Known.

(Special to the Colonist.) NANAIMO, Aug. 2.—The proposition of the miners to accept ten per cent. reduction on all coal dug in Nanaimo was submitted to Manager Robins, last evening but rejected. Mr. Robins wrote the following reply to the men which was read at this morning's mass meeting.

"Gentlamen:-While fully appreciating the feeling that apparently guided your decision yesterday, I cannot say otherwise than what I stated in the memorandum submitted to the meeting yesterday. Anysubmitted to the meeting yesterday. Anything less than a 20 per cent. reduction from the wages of employes earning more than \$3 a day will be useless in the present emergency. One additional statement I will now make namely, I only ask for the reduction to last three months from August I, to October 31. Then I pledge myself to call you together again and will then only ask for such a moderate reduction as may be rea moderate reduction as may
