Chicago, Sept. 12.

At 4 o'clock yesterday on receiving government report a broker said this will not put the wheat up. This morning at Chicago the openings in wheat were all \(\frac{1}{4}\), over and the government reports have been noticed as regularly giving a turn in advancing or in lowering prices. The lowering of wheat prices have now been going on for a long time and the total of the decline has been about 10 cents a bushel.
