Dundas House of Providence Burned.

The House of Providence at Dundas was destroyed by fire on Thursday afternoon, and 200 indigent men and women and orphan children were rendered homeless, and about \$300,000 damage was done.

There were 60 orphans in the institution, and they were sent to St. Joseph's Orphan Asylum at Hamilton. The men were placed in the Drill Hall till arrangements for their keep can be made.

Just how the fire started is not yet known, but it is certain that it was in the stables, which are immediately in the rear of the institution. About 3:00 o'clock Mr. Patrick Griffin, an aged inmate, who does chores around the barn, saw the flames.

Right Rev. Dr. Dowling Bishop of Hamilton, and Right Rev. Dr. McEvoy, Bishop of London, have each subscribed \$100 towards the House of Providence relief fund.

The Parochial Council of St. Vincent de Paul Society has made a grant of \$200 to the sufferers by the House of Providence fire. Mr. Wm. Gibson, M.P., Beamsville, has donated \$50 to the same cause.
