The tables include the statistics most frequently used within the Department when preparing background briefs, ministerial briefings and speeches. The data focus on the G-7 (with special emphasis on Canada and the U.S.). The data are organized in time series on an annual-basis covering at least ten or often more years. CPE updates the database twice a year - in April and October - as the originating statistical agencies issue more recent and revised information.

2. Divisions should note that each table identifies its sources in a footnote and that the sources are available at the DFAIT library. Divisions requiring answers to dayto-day research questions similar to the information provided in the attached database should consult the library's research staff who are available to provide advice and direction on data sources for statistical projects. It will not be efficient for CPE to duplicate basic statistical work for which each Division should be responsible. In addition to assisting you in this work through the creation of the attached database, however, CPE can and will provide methodological advice to officers from other Divisions if sufficient lead time is given. We would appreciate that you circulate this information to all members of your division. Your cooperation in this regard is appreciated.
