Mr. DRUMMOND.—Yes.

Mr. King.—On behalf of the Dominion Marine Association I do not want to discuss the rates at all at this late stage. Here is an answer to what was put in by the Chairman in favour of legislation and the only answer in reference to the legislation, with special reference to the document filed in behalt of the Grain Growers. There is nothing in that argument of theirs.

Senator Young, (Chairman).—I have received communications from the St. John Board of Trade, the Ogilvie Milling Company and others, which will appear in our report. If we receive further documents containing arguments for and against the measure I suppose it is the pleasure of the Committee to have them printed.

Senator LOUGHEED.—Yes.
