

## HENRY LOVE WAS COMMITTED TO TRIAL ON MURDER CHARGE

Many Witnesses Will Be Called by the Crown to Testify  
Against Man Who Is Accused of Killing His Wife—Boy  
Will Give Evidence Against His Father — Little New  
Light on Case.

OWEN SOUND, Ont., March 18.—Accused murderer, Henry Love, Hannah Lucilla Love, his wife, James Ceylon, near Flesherton, on December 9 last, Henry Love will appear in court for his trial tomorrow. After the trial of the case of the late John Lennox this afternoon, the grand jury decided that there was enough evidence to justify the trial of Love. The case of Love was called by the prosecution to his lordship in the morning.

Hundreds of curious people were present to gain admission to the courthouse, which was crowded to the rafters. Arnel Love, whose evidence resulted in the arrest of his father, was present, and seemed to take a great interest in the proceedings. He was made for the hearing of the case.
