

Daily Programme

NOTE—All special attractions and other features are secured for the full term of the Exposition, and are presented daily. In the following programme it is intended to call attention more especially to features which occur only on particular days.

Monday, August 26th

Exhibitors' Preparation Day.—Grounds and buildings open only to exhibitors and concessionaires from 7 a.m. till 6 p.m. All classes of manufactures and other exhibits will be in place and arrangement of same completed by 6 p.m.

Tuesday, August 27th

Opening and Dedication Day.—The grounds and buildings will be open to the public from 9 a.m. The exhibition will be formally opened at 2 o'clock p.m. by the Right Hon. Sir William Laurier, G.C.M.G., Premier of the Dominion of Canada, with appropriate ceremonies in front of the grand stand, after which every department of the exposition will be on view, except the show of live stock, which does not commence until Thursday. A full programme of all the special features as outlined in the previous pages will be given during the afternoon in front of the grand stand and about the grounds. The 2,400 trotting men, military band concerts, the Neapolitan Troubadours, Governor-General's Body Guard, Exposition Band, etc. Buildings close at 6 p.m. to-day only.

Evening.—**GRAND INTERNATIONAL MILITARY TATTOO, RIVOUAC AND BEVELLE** in front of the grand stand on a larger scale and with more brilliancy than ever before. The most beautiful and interesting musical-military spectacle ever presented, with appropriate fireworks, solos, patriotic songs and soul-stirring music and choruses by mixed bands and soloists, quartettes, etc., to be presented on this evening only. The bands engaged for this special occasion will include those of the Queen's Own Rifles, the Royal Grenadiers, the 13th Batt. of Hamilton, the 19th Batt. of St. Catharines, the Buffers Rifles of Bramford, the 48th Highlanders' pipe and drum band, the 12nd Co. of Niagara Falls, N.Y., the Oxford Rifles, Woodstock, the Cadet Battalion, the Governor-General's Body Guard, the
