ARTICLE XIII.

- Sec. 1. Five dollars from each club, with any fines that have been forfeited, will go towards the Trophy for the winning team, who may add to this amount if they choose. One dollar from each club to go towards the League's expenses, if not sufficient the clubs will be levied upon for the deficiency.
- Sec. 2. The Secretary must call a meeting at the close of the season and the winning team can state what they desire for their Trophy, which will be obtained on the approval of the Council.
- Sec. 3. No club in the League will be allowed to change its name without the Council's consent.

ARTICLE XIV.

- Sec. 1. No amendment or alteration shall be made in any part of this Constitution or Laws of Lacrosse except at the Annual Meeting of the League, and by a majority of votes of the clubs represented. Notice of any proposed alteration or amendment must be made to the Secretary of the League in writing, and by him communicated to the clubs in its membership at least one month before it can be voted upon. When notice of alteration or amendment has been given as above both the notice and amendments thereto may be voted upon at the Annual Meeting.
- Sec. 2 Ten delegates shall form a quorum at any meeting.
 - Sec. 3. All votes to be by ballot and then published.
