OUR BIRTHRIGHT SQUANDERED.
The utilization of the water power of the Niagara River for the generation of electricity has been made the basis of a great industrial development on the American side of the river. Large mills have been erected in the vicinity of Niagara Falls, town sites have been laid out and preparations are under way for a great expansion in the estate, business and in manufactures. It is expected that Niagara Falls and Buffalo will become the greatest industrial centres in America and it begins to look as if much of the power that was about the Canadian side of the river? Not a sign of the industrial activity that is apparent across the river. No attempt made to develop electric energy the same as has been done on the other side. There is a greater power centre in the world than the Niagara peninsula. The great volume of power that is passing in a continuous stream from Lake Erie to Lake Ontario can be tapped much more economically on the Canadian than on the American side of the river. In the first place, it will not cost one-fourth as much to install a water power and electric plant on the Canadian side of the river as it has cost on the opposite bank. The physical formation on the Canadian side is such as permits of the development of power at a comparatively small cost. In addition to the power site at the Falls itself it is possible to develop an enormous horse-power at various points along the Niagara escarpment between the Falls and Hamilton. The Welland River, which is practically on the same level as Lake Erie) can be tapped at various points. It comes within eight miles of the power site at Thorold, and again it is about the same distance from the precipice of the Jordan River. There is no doubt in the world the Niagara peninsula is destined to become one of the greatest of the world's greatest power and manufacturing centres of Canada. The Ontario Government, however, has adopted a policy which produces stagnation on this side while a state of activity reigns across the river. The Government has refused a great blunder in disposing of our immense water power at the Falls for a paltry \$25,000 a year. Moreover, they have disposed of it to a foreign company, to the company that owns the franchise on the American side. While this company has spent millions of dollars during the past three or four years on the American side of the river not a move has been made in Canada. It is an open secret, in fact, that the American company has secured our water power merely to prevent it passing into the hands of some company that might compete with them. They do not want to use it themselves so much as they are anxious to get out as soon as they can. In a couple of months Niagara Falls power will be delivered in Buffalo, while several thousand horse power has for many months been drying machinery at Niagara Falls and vicinity. The Americans have got hold of our most valuable water power, preventing our own people from using it, much in the same way as they have secured possession of our timber limits and monopolized our railroads. Our valuable timber limits were never more outrageously sacrificed than has been the water power of the Niagara River. Within ten years the six railways running east and west through the peninsula and the two running north and south will all be operated by power generated by the waters of Lake Erie. Great manufacturing establishments will be in operation all over the peninsula, and it is not too much of a stretch of the imagination to state that by that time Hamilton and Toronto will receive all their power for light and motive work from Niagara or other water systems. All this magnificent prospect our Government has squandered for \$25,000, or \$25,000 after ten years. And not only that, the company that possesses the franchise is a foreign one and not concerned at all in the welfare of this country. We have sold our birthright for a mess of pottage.

AN OVERCROWDED PROFESSION.
The Canadian Medical Review cautions young men against taking up medicine as a profession. It is not a lucrative one, and the average reader to learn that in Ontario we have one doctor for every 600 of the population, men, women and children included. According to the editor of The Review, one-third of the medical men now in practice in Ontario can do no work at all, and the other two-thirds are overburdened with professional cases. The regular sickness, accidents, maternity, inquiries, insurance, all combined, will not, it is claimed, yield on an average for all the practitioners of Ontario an income better than that made by a well-to-do mechanic, or dairy-farm clerk. Young men should make a note of these facts and give the medical colleges a wide berth. There are scores of less pretentious occupations to which the aspiring youth of Canada had better turn their attention.

Commercial travelers, bank clerks, accountants in good houses, many insurance men, are all making more money, and with much less anxiety, than the great bulk of medical practitioners.

THEY ARE DEPLORABLE.
This is the opinion of the School Inspectors of the Province of Quebec—Gambler Heavily Fined.

Montreal, Aug. 27.—(Special.)—The World's Fair is held to-day that never again would a school inspectors convention be held in the city of Quebec. The reason for this is that too many hard truths were told when the inspectors of the province met together at this convention last year. It will be remembered that one after another of the Roman Catholic school inspectors arose and detailed the deplorable condition of the schools in their respective provinces. The revelations, in fact, created a sensation throughout Canada. The Government has since then been endeavoring to reform in elementary education. The inspectors who had endured Senator Masson's attacks against the present system before the Council of Public Instruction were highly indignant when the inspectors themselves opened fire all along the line. They are not satisfied with the present state of affairs, and they will abolish the inspectors, was the cry. It is a hard task to perform, but it will be done. At the present time, the better elements of the province are thoroughly aroused over the inferiority of Quebec's primary schools and nine out of ten of the children of the province are as to the future of their own schools than those of distant Manitoba.
