## FLAG FALLS AT WOODBINE TO-DAY WEATHER PROMISED—FINE, WARM

Inferno, Will King and Maid of Barrie, They Should Finish in Plate.

The weather man appreciates the importance of opening day of the Ontario Jockey Club, and the historic race for the Plate. So naturally the climatic conditions for this spring's guinea, which looks almost a toss-up between the representatives of Seagram and Dymont, were correct, and the afternoon will be fine and warm. The track at Woodbine will be fast, which, according to expert evidence, is a point in favor of Inferno. Each stable will send a pair to the front, and the Seagram colt is selected to win the Dymont entry should beat the rest of the field for the place and show. Of the outsiders, Chappell Boy and Cross of Gold have received late support. Tommy Burns was sent for to ride Will King—\$1000 if he won, which sum he asked win or lose. There is altogether a program of seven races, the other features including the Minto selling stakes and the Royal Canadian steeplechase. First is the opening dash with such well-known names as Tongador, Claude and Capet Sance, then a half-mile incident with twenty-two two-year-olds before the three stakes events that are followed by the Carleton purse and the extra race, which is the seventh and last.

Starter Murray will take the horses in hand for the first event at 4:30, a half-hour being allowed for each race up to the King's Plate, at 4:30. The official luncheon will take place at the clubhouse at 12:45 p.m., and the governor-general is expected to be in attendance. His excellency will present the King's Plate to the owner of the winner after the race.

The racing officials are: Steward, H. O. Tullimadge; judge, A. S. Post; associate judge, Francis Nelson; starter, W. M. Murray; clerk of the scales and patrol judge, Fred Gerhardt; timers, R. W. Davies and Joe Doane.
