The parish of St. Luke's having been separated from that of St. Paul's, a local committee was organized in the latter, which has sent the above handsome contribution, and transmitted the following extract from its report:—

Extract of report of the local committee, St. Luke's Church, Halifax, adopted at a general meeting of the parishioners of St. Luke's.

"Of our contributions to the general objects of the Society, we are entitled by a standing rule to reserve *one-fourth*, for the purchase of books, or for the endowment of the parish.

"To make this claim in favor of the city church of St. Luke's, the committee think would be inconsistent with the Christian liberality which has been exhibited by the parishioners; but there is a large district extending *twenty miles* along the Western shore, forming an integral part of the parish, but receiving little or no effective share of its ministrations, the inhabitants of which are very poor, uneducated, and greatly exposed to sins and errors of every kind.

To remedy this evil the Committee propose that the privilege should be exercised in favor of these destitute settlements, and that one-fourth of the contributions be claimed for the endowment of the Western District of the Parish.
