of timber was \$15,198.06. Fifty per cent of this would make \$7,599.00 available for distribution to the Indians. In February last, there was distributed \$1,450.00 and in April \$8,900.00 and new \$1,460.00 which will leave a balance undistributed of \$1,769.00.

The distribution should be made as soon as you can and pay-lists, in duplicate, submit ted here accounting for the advance remitting any belance undistributed using as a basis the last pay-list and be careful in submitting the duplicate that it is an exact copy of the original. You will also make a third copy to be kept in your office for reference.
