

The recipes for kippered herring and fried haddock, mentioned above, are as follows:

Kippered herring—Remove the fish from can and arrange on a platter that may be put in the oven. Sprinkle with pepper, brush over with lemon juice and dripping, and pour over the liquor left in the can. Heat thoroughly and garnish if so desired.

Fried haddock—Cut into suitable sizes for frying. Roll in cornmeal, sifted oatmeal or flour. Fry in frying-pan in hot fat. Brown on each side. If a garnish is desired, use lemon or parsley.

Canadian Food Controller's Suggestions of War-time Dishes For Friday

Save beef and bacon by preparing tempting dishes. Coddled fish balls are delicious.

**Coddled Fish Balls**

Wash fish in cold water, and pick in very small pieces, or cut, using scissors. Wash, pare and soak potatoes, cutting in pieces of uniform size before measuring. Cook fish and potatoes in boiling water to cover until potatoes are soft. Drain thoroughly through strainer, return to kettle in which they were cooked, mash thoroughly (being sure there are no lumps left in potato), add butter, egg well beaten, and pepper. Beat with a fork two minutes. Add salt if necessary. Take up by spoonful, put in frying-basket and fry one minute in deep fat, allowing six fish balls for each frying; drain on brown paper. Re-heat the fat after each frying.

Use whole wheat flour often—it saves wheat.

**ECUADOR PREPARES TO BREAK WITH GERMANY**

Without comment or explanation the Ecuadorian foreign minister notified Minister Elvade on Monday that his government had instructed its minister in Peru to advise the German minister there that he could not be formally received at the Ecuadorian capital. By state department officials and diplomats in Washington the action of Ecuador has been construed as practically equivalent to a rupture of relations with Germany.

Dr. Peri was appointed minister to both Peru and Ecuador and after the declaration of war by the United States, he mailed his credentials to Quito. The Ecuadorian government refused to recognize such informal presentation. Diplomats at Washington were convinced however that Ecuador's refusal to receive the minister, now that he is willing to go to Quito, was carefully calculated as an indication of the country's intention to join the majority of South American nations already aligned against Germany.
