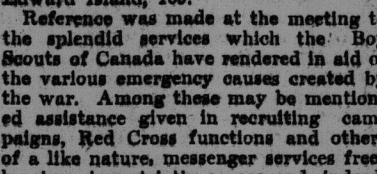

Membership and Scope of Work  
Have Both Largely Increased—  
H. R. H. Presides at Meeting

The excellent progress made by the  
Canadian branch of the Boy Scouts As-  
sociation during the last few weeks was  
shown at a meeting of the Canadian  
General Council on Saturday afternoon,  
which was held in Ottawa under the  
presidency of His Royal Highness, the  
Duke of Connaught, Chief Scout for  
Canada.

Other members of the executive com-  
mittee present were Sir Henry Egna,  
Colonel A. P. Sherwood, Dominion chief  
commissioner of the Boy Scouts' As-  
sociation for Canada, Lt.-Col. E. A. Stanton,  
secretary to His Royal Highness and  
treasurer of the Canadian general coun-  
cil, Lt.-Col. G. B. Sturges, of Montreal,  
commissioner for the province of Que-  
bec, Lt.-Col. Noel G. L. Marshall, who is  
also the chief executive of the Red Cross  
Society for Canada, F. H. Gibbons, N. C.  
honorary Dominion counsel of the  
Canadian branch of the Boy Scouts' As-  
sociation, Dr. J. W. Robertson, Major  
Arthur A. Farnham and General H. Brown,  
honorary Dominion secretary.

There were also present H. G. Ham-  
mond, Toronto, provincial secretary,  
assistant commissioner for the province  
of Ontario, H. A. Lordy, provincial sec-  
retary for the province of Quebec, Re-  
inald G. Smith, Dominion organizing sec-  
retary, and F. A. Perrot, who has re-  
cently been representing the Canadian  
General Council in its organization work  
in the maritime provinces.

The statement prepared from the cen-  
sus returns sent into Ottawa headquar-  
ters by the various provinces shows that  
the boy scout movement in Canada has  
made considerable numerical expansion  
as well as increased efficiency during the  
last few months. At the end of June, 1915,  
there were upwards of 16,000 boy scouts  
in Canada, an increase of nearly 5,000 over  
figures for the preceding year. These  
were made up as follows:

Ontario, 7,213; Alberta, 3,141; Que-  
bec, 1,406; Manitoba, 1,271; British Co-  
lumbia, 1,089; Saskatchewan, 909; New  
Brunswick, 881.
