- 2. Students may obtain the standing in the University of Toronto of Undergraduates of the second year by regularly attending the College Lectures, and satisfactorily passing the College Examinations in all the departments, appointed by the University as necessary for Undergraduates of the first year.
- 3. Students may obtain the standing in the University of Toronto of Undergraduates of the fourth year by regularly attending the College Lectures, and satisfactorily passing the College Examinations in all the departments, appointed by the University as necessary for Undergraduates of the third year, but they must also satisfactorily pass the University Examinations in the Mathematics of the first year.
- 4. Matriculated Students are required to attend the Lectures and Examinations in all the departments, appointed by the University of Toronto as necessary for Students of their respective standings. Certificates of attendance, during one or more Academic years, will be given to those Matriculated Students, who have been regular in their attendance on the required Lectures, and who have passed the required Examinations.
- 5. Matriculated Students are required to reside, during the period of their attendance on Lectures, in the College, or in such houses as have been selected by their parents or guardians, or approved by the President.
- Students who reside in the College, are under the immediate charge of the Dean of Residence, Professor Buckland.
- 7. Students and Occasional Students are admitted to Lectures on application to the Professors in the respective depart-
