Domestic Parliament.

Parliament was opened at Ottawa on Thursday last. The Speech from the Throne did not forebode anything of an unusual or gratifying nature respecting legislation or Government policy...

On returning from the Senate to the Commons, Speaker Kirkpatrick presented to the House various papers connected with elections held since last session and the newly-elected members were then introduced.

Mr. Mackenzie's health is excellent. Messrs Langelier and Edgar will be welcome additions to the active fighters in the opposition ranks.

On the Speaker taking the chair, petitions were presented by Messrs. Fleming, McLean, Harley and Taylor praying that no alteration be made in relation to the Scott Act unless it be of a prohibitive character.

Mr. Mackenzie presented a petition signed by 500 persons, praying for the removal of Chinese immigrants from the Province of Ontario.

Mr. Taché, recently elected for Beauport, made the reply to the speech from the Throne. He speaks French, and referred at some length to the development of the North West.

Mr. Taché, (Canadian, N. S.) seconded the address. His speech was rather unimpressive, and fell flat upon the House. It was, as Mr. Blake put it, euphemistic and hyperbolic.

Mr. Blake announced opposition cheer, and after paying the customary compliments to preceding speakers, criticized the past promises of the Government respecting the press of grain, and contrasted them with the low prices of today.
