### Notice of Sale

THERE WILL BE SOLD, for the purpose of satisfying the principal money and interest secured by the said Mortgage, default having been made in the payment thereof, as therein provided, at Public Auction, in front of the Court House at the Town of Edmundston, in the County of Madawaska and Provinces of New Brunswick, on Tuesday, the seventeenth day of July A. D. 1923, at the hour of Eleven o'clock in the forenoon, all the lands and premises described in the said Indenture of Mortgage as follows:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the Parish of St. Leonard in the County of Madawaska and Province of New Brunswick, described and bounded as follows:

"Beginning at a post standing on the eastern side of reserved road adjoining easterly lot number 27 granted to N. Corbin, Harrison Brook settlement, the said post being on the southern side of another reserved road adjoining southerly lot numbers 35 and 36 in the said settlement, then from said place of beginning and running by the magnet of the year 1915 north sixtysix degrees east along the last mentioned side of reserved road thirty chains and twenty three links to a post standing on the Northwest side of a reserved road at the most easterly angle of lot 202, granted to J. McMillan in Deadbrooks Settlement; thence running by the magnet North 45 Degrees, West 67 chains to the Southwest side of another reserved road; thence along the same North 45 Degrees East 15 Chains; thence South 45 Degrees East 67 chains to a cedar tree standing on the Northwest side of the aforesaid reserved road, and thence along the same South 45 Degrees west, 15 chains to place of beginning, containing one acre, more or less, and distinguishing as Lot No. 202 in the Coldbrook Settlement East.
