Corning, N. Y., July 10.—That Wm. Schroeder, engineer of the express train which ran into the rear end of the Lackawanna passenger train No. 9, here, last Thursday, causing the deaths of 40 persons in the resulting wreck, was apparently intoxicated at 12:30 o'clock on the morning of July 4th within four hours of the time he boarded the engine which he guided to destruction, was the testimony given at the coroner's inquest here this afternoon by Charles Klapproth of Elmira, for many years a close personal friend of Schroeder. This testimony came near the end of a very weary afternoon session presided over by Coroner Herbert B. Smith in his shirt sleeves, with jurymen, lawyers, representatives of the Interstate Commerce Commission and other similarly garbed.
