THE WAR IS THE THEME OF ADDRESS TO IMPERIALISTS

Mr. Caesar Barranco's Able Speech Before the Members of the Imperial League—Cuba's Part in the War.

"The German Empire, by her want on savagery and cruelty, has defeated her own aims and buried her name under a load of crimes her race can never outlive. Her race of reckoning is near at hand." Such were the words uttered by Caesar A. Barranco in an eloquent speech before the Canadian Imperial League recently. Mr. Barranco displayed a thorough knowledge of his subject and he painted in vivid colors the splendid loyalty and unselfish heroism displayed by the Canadians, not only in the trenches, but at home as well. He also graphically portrayed certain phases of "German Kultur" and pointed out her underhand way of waging war. He showed also that though Cuba was a small nation, she was doing her "bit" to help bring the war to a successful culmination.

Mr. Barranco spoke in part as follows:—

"As I listened to the talk of the gallant Colonel McAvity recently relating incidents of the life and heroism of your boys at the front, my thoughts wandered back to that memorable day June 23rd, 1915 when Col. McAvity at the head of his gallant 26th Battalion marched past my office on Prince William street on their way to board the transport, "Caledonia" which was for the liberation of the oppressed peoples of Belgium and France and the cause of humanity. And the sight that touched me most deeply on that memorable day was the long line of gray haired women, mothers of these brave boys, with tears streaming down their cheeks as they bade farewell to their loved ones about to depart, and still in their sorrow I could note the proud look in their faces; the satisfaction they felt that their brave boys were doing their duty to the Mother Country and to the cause of humanity. And I said to myself, what man would not glory in belonging to a race capable of producing such brave, noble and patriotic women."

"Your patriotism and your loyalty to the Motherland in the great struggle has won for you the admiration of the whole world. War, like death, brings us all face to face with grim reality. And to you people, three thousand miles from the scene of conflict, from political intrigue, commercial conspiracies, and racial rivalries, that have made conflict inevitable, this war is the birth travail of

HON. P. J. VENIOT ON AN INSPECTION TOUR

Hon. P. J. Veniot, minister of public works, was in the city yesterday, told The Standard that with the road engineer, Mr. Burton A. Hill, he spent several days of the week in an inspection of the roads in Westmorland, Albert, Kings and St. John counties. He will meet the provincial bridge engineer, Mr. A. R. Wetmore, in the city today and together they will inspect the bridges of St. John and Kings counties.

Mr. Veniot said that he is anxious to get the new road machinery at work on the roads. He also made the announcement that by next week he expected to have the roads of the province under district engineers with crews in charge of the various sections. In addition to the northern divisions which will start out on the roads from Fredericton to St. John; Moncton to St. John; St. John to Woodstock, and St. John to St. Andrews and St. Stephen.
