### Common Council Met In Committee

New Equipment for Public Works Department — Re-newal of Leases at Increased Rates - Discussion on Taking Over of Lansdowne

Avenue.

Authority for the purchase of new equipment for the Public Works department, to be paid for by bond issue, was voted in committee of the Common Council yesterday. Other matters included renewal of certail leases at increased rates; discussion of the proposed taking over of Lansdowne avenue, and appointment of Alfred Boyce as veterinary surgeon of the Safety department.

Authority was granted for the sale to the lessee, John D. McLeod, of lot 958' Guys wards, for \$300. The lot is held under a rental of \$14, and the lease expires in two years. The area is 50 by 100.

Authority was granted for renewal of the lease to lot 930, corner Wentworth and Mecklenburg streets, to A. S. Hartt; also for a new division of the property to be done by the city engineer at the expense of the lessee.

On motion of Commissioner Thornton, authority was granted for the issue to A. C. Smith of a five-year renewable lease to the theatre and office area on the first floor of City Hail, West, at an annual rental of \$450, on condition that Mr. Smith heat the City Hail lockup from a hot air fursace he proposes to install; that the heating plant be subject to approval of the city engineer and the building inspector; that the city pay half the cost of installation—in no case to exceed \$400—should the lease not be renewed at the end of five years, and that Mr. Smith install a new toilet. The present rental is \$420.36, and the lease expires in two years.

Commissioner Fisher was instructed to report on the cost of grading Lansdowne avenue, and providing a suggested sewer outlet via Newman's Brook.


