THE HARDWOOD SITUATION.

Some of the wholesale and retail yard men in Chicago say that they are having a brisk inquiry for stock, largely in small lots, as the average consumer does not care to purchase more than sufficient to keep him running from day to day. Large consumers are not buying much, excepting some of those outside of the city who are contracting quite a quantity of stock for delivery in January and February. As a rule, however, buying on any large scale has been postponed until after the first of the year and the wholesale trade is not handling more than can be com-

fortably supplied from the moderate stocks at hand.

One of the most encouraging features of the situation, says the American Lumberman, is that inquiries are increasing in number for delivery early next year. Several firms in this market have recently remarked on this feature of the situation, which they say promises a continuously active market after the middle of January. One dealer states that his inquiry for deliveries early in the coming year are about as plentiful as he ever had.

Prices have not shown much of a tendency to sag despite the falling off in demand. Quarter sawed white oak has shown a slight weakness and yet few holders are sacrificing it, as they realize that this is not the season of the year for consumption and are content to hold until the demand naturally rises, which will no doubt take place shortly after the first of the year. Quarter sawed red oak is holding firm. Plain white oak and red oak are both steady and inquiries for future delivery on the increase.

Basewood displays some weakness, but this is no doubt merely owing to the temporary lack of demand. Former consumers of basewood have had their attention largely called to other woods of late and this has caused an apparent plentiful supply of basewood, which really is not the case, as there is scarcely any variety of lumber that is in less supply. Rock elm has lately come to the front and the demand continues unabated, with light supply to draw from. White ash continues a much wanted article in all markets and both mills and assembling points are said to be out of stock.
