INTERCOLONIAL RAILWAY :

1. House goes into committee in reference to a change of gauge on the Intercolonial and other Government Railways in New Brunswick and Nova Scotia; His Excellency's recommendation signified; Report Resolutions for a change of gauge to 4 ft. 8½ in., and authorising a third rail to be laid on any such railways; Bill presented, 205. See *infra*, 2.

2. Bill to amend the Act respecting the construction of the Intercolonial Railway; Ordered; Presented, 205. Read second and third times; Passed, 231. By the Senate, 293. R.A., 434. (36 Vic., c. 45.)

3. House resolves to go into committee with respect to the authorization of the payment of certain contractors for Sections Nos. 1 to 7, of the Railway, 333. Considered, 425. Report a series of Resolutions; Agreed to, 432.

4. Motion in reference to certain over-payments to contractors for Section No. 5, offered in amendment a question of Supply, and negatived, 252, 262.
