## BILL.

An Act in further amendment of the General Inspection Act.

ER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada enacts as Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :---

1. Subsection 1 of section 2 of The General Inspection Act, R.S.C., c. 99, 5 chapter 99 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of <sup>s. 2 amended</sup>. chapter 23 of the statutes of 1892, is hereby further amended

by adding thereto the following paragraph :---

"(j.) Fruit."

2. The said Act, as amended by section 7 of chapter 23 of Section 10 the statutes of 1892, is hereby further amended by adding at added. the end thereof the following section :---

## "FRUIT.

"112. No inspector of fruit shall brand, mark or certify Fruit not to any fruit as inspected, unless it is packed in the manner here- be inspected unless packed. inafter required; but any fruit not so packed, submitted for

15 inspection, shall, by the inspector to whom it is submitted, be Packing by repacked in the manner hereinafter required, and the inspector iuspector. shall receive the actual cost of such new packages as are required for such repacking, and the further sum of five cents Fees. for each package so repacked as compensation for his time and

20 labour.

"2. Fruits of any kind shall be packed in a substantial Mode of manner by the grower or the purchaser thereof and shall be packing. put up in barrels, boxes, baskets or crates, with the name of each kind of fruit marked on each package, the grade and the 25 name of the grower, or if packed by a shipper, then his name

on each package.

"3. The branding of different qualities of fruits shall be as Brands. follows: The best quality shall be branded No. 1; the second quality shall be branded No. 2; the third quality shall be 30 branded No. 3; the fourth quality shall be branded No. 4; and

the fifth quality shall be branded Culls.

"4. The duty of an inspector shall be to inspect five pack- Mode of ages representing No. 1, 2, 3, 4 and culls, and if all five are inspection. found according to the marks, it shall be his duty to consider 35 the lots represented duly inspected, without opening every package: Provided that, if the purchaser or any one interested re-quires it, the inspector shall openfive other packages bearing the same marks, and if he finds them in the same good condition, then the whole shall be considered in the same good condition;
