

of the Act hereinbefore repealed, it shall be lawful for the Superior Court or for any Judge or Circuit Judge holding the Circuit Court, if the party aggrieved shall think fit to complain to him, to enquire into such matter in a summary way and for that purpose to summon and enforce the attendance of all necessary parties, and to make such order thereupon for the repayment of any sum of money extorted, or for the due payment of any money so levied or received as aforesaid, and for the payment of such costs to the party aggrieved as such Court, Judge or Circuit Judge shall think just; and in default of immediate payment of any sum of money so ordered to be paid by such Bailiff or by such officer, to commit the offender to the Common Gaol of the District, there to be detained until such payment be made in full: and the provisions of this section shall apply as well to any act of misconduct or neglect committed by any Bailiff before this Act shall come fully into effect, as after that time.

CXIV. And be it enacted, That the salary of each of the said Circuit Judges shall not exceed                      pounds per annum, and such salary shall be in lieu of all fees, emoluments, or allowances whatever, whether for travelling expenses or otherwise.

CXV. And be it enacted, That the Interpretation Act shall apply to this Act; and that all the provisions thereof shall be liberally construed so as best to promote the attainment of justice in every case, and no construction shall be deemed right which shall leave any provision thereof without effect; and if there be any case in which, before this Act shall come fully into effect, a party would have had the means of enforcing or defending some just claim or right in some Court then existing, and no provision shall be found in this Act under which such claim or right can be enforced or maintained, such provision shall be made by the Rules of Practice to be made under
