**800 households surveyed**

The Mississauga recreation and parks department is asking residents of Mississauga to assist them in evaluating existing recreational activities and indoor facilities by completing a survey which requests the opinions and interests of the residents.

For planning purposes Mississauga has been divided into 28 districts according to residential and geographical boundaries. The research statistics compiled from the surveys are then graded by using the common element — the number of residents in each specific community.

In co-operation with the Mississauga recreation and parks department, the city's policy planning division has produced the recreation questionnaire.

The survey form was mailed to 8,000 randomly-selected households in Mississauga.

The recreation and parks department is including a free swimming pass, entitling up to five people in each household to take advantage of a free swim at any one of the city's thirteen pools. The passes will also provide residents who have not used city facilities with an opportunity to utilize an indoor or outdoor pool.

The recreation and parks department intends to continue the practise bi-annually. The parks study will again be evaluated in 1978.

Statistics compiled through the survey are expected to be released in the fall of this year.

**If you buy sight-unseen**

Canadian mail order houses do an incredible \$3 billion worth of business each year. That's an astounding figure when one realizes that it is money derived from customers willing to pay in advance for merchandise sight unseen.

From January to March, the Better Business Bureau of Canada received 563 complaints from dissatisfied customers, complaints ranging from non-delivery to misrepresentation.

The total number of complaints for the year.

based on the figure for the first quarter, will probably be close to 2,400 unhappy customers. That's quite a few.

The majority of mail order houses try to give customer satisfaction — about 77 per cent of all complaints over a year are settled to the customer's satisfaction.

Many of the problems originate with the fly-by-nighters. The mail order business, by its very nature (the fact that money is paid in advance), attracts unscrupulous characters who have no fixed address and use only a box number through which to conduct their nefarious operations.

These characters quickly cash the cheques and money orders sent by trusting customers. They make a swift killing, then vanish into thin air, leaving the customer at a dead-end.
