

thus showing more to be in those two blocks by  $\frac{56}{100}$  of an Acre than was sold to Mr John R. Martin.

And the same Plan states the quantity of land required by the Canada Air Line Railway at 3 Acres and  $\frac{7}{100}$  of an Acre, being less by  $\frac{16}{100}$  of an Acre than was actually assigned to the Great Western Railway Company by Mr John R. Martin. And should that Plan and Description be followed in making out the Patent to Mr Edward Martin, more land would be granted to him than was apparently assigned to him by Mr John R. Martin: and consequently the Great Western Railway Company would have less patented to them than Mr J. R. Martin has assigned

to them. - You will please communicate with the parties interested with a view to their furnishing correct descriptions of the land claimed by them, in order that it may be properly described in each Patent.
