With Cheque.

Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 23rd ultimo, and the voucher rendered at \$113.50 which you forwarded from Dr Tozer for professional services rendered to Indians of the Big Cove Reserve, I beg to say that in consequence of the report made thereon by the Chief Medical Officer it has been decided to make payment in full at \$101.50, and I enclose herewith cheque No 224 for that amount. In explanation I may say that in 18 cases where the doctor charged \$1.00 for medicines when making ordinary visits ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ the said charges have been reduced by 50¢, while the charge of \$4.00 in the case of Sylvanus Ghish's wife has been reduced from \$4.00 to \$2.00, and the charge of \$3.00 in the case of Noel Nicholas has been reduced to \$2.00, making a total reduction of \$12.00 in the whole account.
