


Ottawa, 24th June, 1904.

Sir,-

I have to request that you will accompany G. P. Cockburn, Esq., Indian Agent, at the Robinson Treaty payments to be made in the Nipissing district. This is Mr. Cockburn's first payment and it is thought advisable to request you to accompany him in order that he may be properly instructed in the method of making Robinson Treaty payments. Mr. Cockburn will, of course, be responsible for the correctness of the payment, but you should give him whatever guidance and assistance is necessary.
