number of pupils it is proposed to have enrolled at the old sun's school, be two teachers, one for the junior pupils and one for the senior. Both should have professional training to be able to attain success in their work. With regard to the minor officials of the staff it is not considered necessary to make any remarks.

As Your Lordship has had extensive experience in the schools in the Diocese of Calgary it is thought that you are eminently fitted to judge as to the qualifications of those who offer their services for the offices of principal and matron, as well as for the other positions, and it is hoped that before the time comes to open the school Your Lordship will have completed arrangements for an efficient staff.
