Sir:-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 4th instant, with which you submitted a list of drugs which you state are required for use by Dr. Orok; and in reply I beg to say that in view of the fact that a large requisition was recently approved, an explanation is required from you as to why this additional large list of drugs is asked for. Only \$500.00 is provided to cover the cost of drugs for your Agency. The list ordered recently cost \$420.00. Authority to have the present requisition filled will not be granted unless very good reasons are given as to why it should be filled. Dr. Larose no doubt ordered what was necessary and it is not understood why his successor should now send in a further requisition. You should have explained when forwarding the requisition.
