Question - How much petrol was in the right tank. Answer - One of the tanks was filled, Question - What was the speedometer reading when you took over the

Answer - Speedometer was broken. Question - Do you know how much petrol was in both tanks when you parked the vehicle on 7 Feb 44. Answer - I do not know.
