18. It shall be the duty of the Auditors to audit the accounts of the Secretary, Treasurer, Librarian and Trustees, before they are presented to the annual meeting.

TRUSTEES.

19. It shall be the duty of the trustees, to hold in trust for the Society all property real or otherwise (except the books belonging to the Library.) and submit the same for the approval of the members whenever called, render an annual account of the property held in trust by them and deliver it up to their successors when they are elected.

SEANCES.

- 20. There shall be two meetings weekly—Súnday and Thursday evenings,—for the holding of Seances, and such further purposes as shall be deemed best in the interests of Spiritualism.
- 21. Every member of the Society shall be allowed to introduce a friend at the Sunday evening meetings (with due respect to Article 1.)
- 22. The Thursday evening meetings shall be open for members only (well known mediums, however, being always admitted). Any meetings, except the business meetings, may be devoted to public lectures, at the discretion of the President.

HARMONY.

23. As the success of the Society entirely depends on the maintenance of good harmony, it shall be lawful, when it is thought desirable that a member withdraw from the Society, to call a special meeting, by at least eight days notice, and
