

and in having distinctly finer and more delicate striae, which are also a little shallower; the puncta in the striae are similarly obscure, but the punctuation of the interspaces more profuse and more delicate. The length of the fragment is 1.8^{mm} , and the breadth, 1.3^{mm} ; the real length of the elytron may have been nearly 4^{mm} .
